Here are the two websites that carry the majority of the supplies and the "shopping list" for the class. As they will need to purchase some items that I either brought or lent to them for the class, the cost will be higher than the \$30 materials fee I charged, however, they will own all the tools and materials. I estimated approximately \$60-\$100 depending on their individual choices and what they might already have on hand. Tax and shipping are additional.

- 1. A pair of wheeled nippers. Leponitt brand preferred (\$25) but \$15 ones are ok.
- 2. One pair of tweezers—locking or non-locking is optional
- 3. One 8" x 8" or 10" x 10" wood base/substrate. WEM have wood ones that have the 1/8" lip that works with the glass we'll be using. MAS have w/o lip
- 4. Vitreous Glass tile—An assortment of colors—can buy a minimum of 25pc on WEM website
- 5. Weldbond adhesive 5.4 oz
- 6. Polyblend sanded grout smallest size—Light neutrals recommended--not premixed,
- 7. a plastic deli-food storage container for mixing the grout, and
- 8. Nitrile disposable gloves
- 9. Optional—safety glasses. If they already wear glasses that's fine, otherwise the safety glasses are recommended.

Optional tesserae available for purchase in small quantities, depending on individual budget and preference:

10.Stained glass if it's already cut in shapes and/or smallish pieces

- 11.Mirror tile
- 12.Van Gogh glass
- 13.Cinca unglazed porcelain
- 14. Glass gems

All glass or tesserae need to be flat and no thicker than 1/8''

Design ideas for initial project:

- Suggest using simple imagery and one basic focal point, i.e. a butterfly, Bird, Animal, Tree, Fruit etc.
- Abstract designs, symmetrical or not
- Symbols—spirals, mandalas, hamsa, Buddha, moon, eyes, lotus
